Introduction

We gather and use certain information about individuals in order to provide products and services.

What data we gather

We may collect the following information:

- Name and any linked names such as Spouses who may be included in the delivery of services
- Contact Address information including 'optionally' an email address
- Other information relevant to client enquiries and delivery of services

How we use this data

Collecting this data allows us to deliver our services.

Specifically, we may use data:

- For our own internal records.
- To contact you in response to a specific enquiry or the delivery of a service

How can you correct data we hold?

If you believe, we hold personal data on you and wish to request access to it or to correct it you can make a request through our contact page.

Please provide as much information as you can about what data you believe we hold and what corrections should be made.

For personal data that we have about you:

- **Delete Data:** You can ask us to erase or delete all or some of your personal data (e.g., if it is no longer necessary to provide Services to you).
- **Change or Correct Data:** You can edit some of your personal data through your account. You can also ask us to change, update or fix your data in certain cases, particularly if it's inaccurate.
- **Object to, or Limit or Restrict, Use of Data:** You can ask us to stop using all or some of your personal data (e.g., if we have no legal right to keep using it) or to limit our use of it (e.g., if your personal data is inaccurate or unlawfully held).

Right to Access and/or Take Your Data: You can ask us for a copy of your personal data and can ask for a copy of personal data you provided in machine readable form.

Data Retention

We may hold your data indefinitely, however unless required for meeting legal obligation it may be purged within 7 years.

Controlling information about you

We will never lease, distribute or sell your personal information to third parties unless we have your permission, or the law requires us to.

Any personal information we hold about you is stored and processed under our data protection policy, in line with the Data Protection Act 1998.

Business Transaction

If Crouch Vale Veterinary Practice is involved in a merger, acquisition or asset sale, your Personal Information may be transferred. We will provide notice before your Personal Information is transferred and becomes subject to a different Privacy Policy. In the event of such a transfer of information, your rights under the Data Protection Act 1998 are not affected.

Security

The security of your Personal Information is important to us, all personal information is stored securely. However, if we communicate with you via electronic solutions such as email, remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your Personal Information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security. As such we make no warranties as to the level of security afforded to your data, except that we will always act in accordance with the relevant UK and EU legislation.

If you are located outside United Kingdom and choose to provide information to us, please note that we transfer the information, including Personal Information, to United Kingdom and process it there.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by your submission of such information represents your agreement to that transfer.

If you do not wish to be communicated with electronically, you may decline to provide such contact information and request that you are not contacted such.

International Transfer

Your information, including Personal Information, may be transferred to — and maintained on — computers located outside of your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ than those from your jurisdiction. (Such as Office 365, etc.)

Any data that we store or host on your behalf will be retained within the European Economic Community, unless you request otherwise in writing.

Communications

We may use your Personal Information to contact you with newsletters, marketing or promotional materials and other information that may be of interest to you. You may opt out of receiving any, or all, of these communications from us by contacting us.
